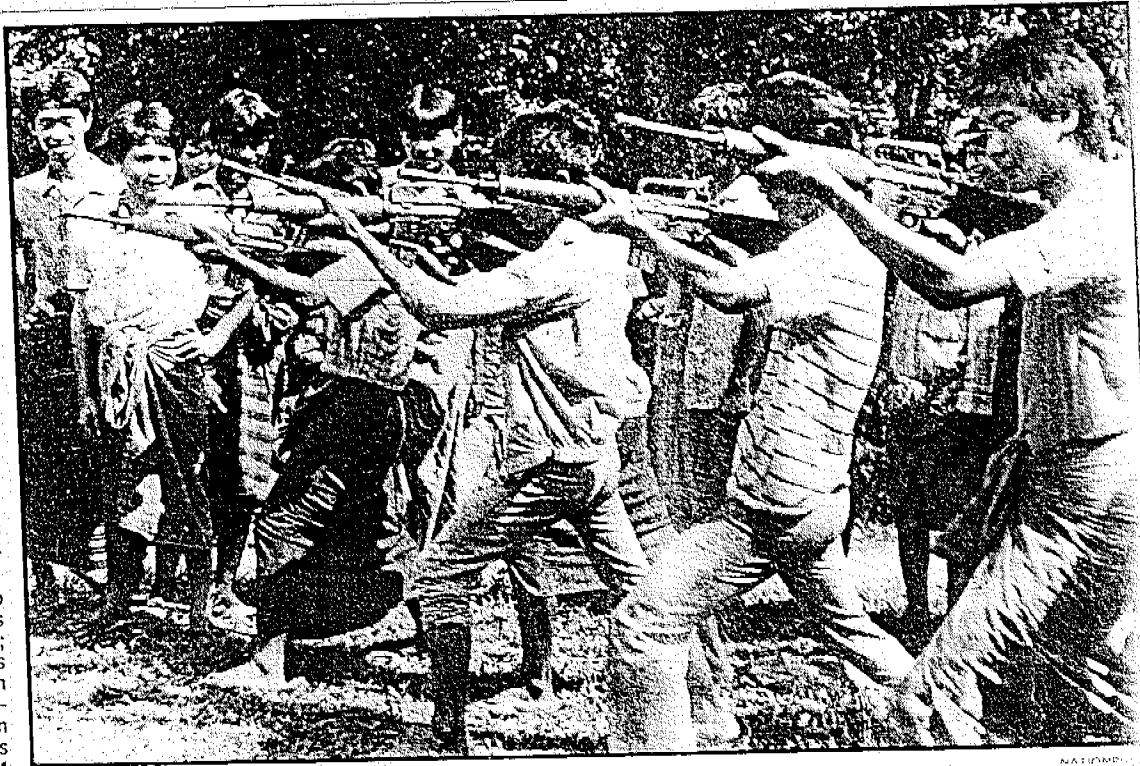
Taking up arms

BURMESE students are given basic arms training with M-16 assault rifles at the Karens' Kie Day camp, opposite Tha Song Yang District of Tak on Wednesday.

More than 1,000 Burmese students fleeing military repression are believed to have arrived at the camps of Karen minority groups near the Thai border.

One of the students, who identified himself as Saw Kyang Tun, told *The Nation* that he wants to contact Thai students and seek their support.
